Annual Provincial Dues & Financial Report

Each OCDS member is required to submit annual provincial dues of \$35 in the month of February. The treasurer for each Community or Group collects the dues from the members and sends a consolidated check to the OCDS Central Office, P.O. Box 347, Oakville, CA 94562. A financial report for the Community or Group should also be included. (A year-end bank statement is sufficient.) Aspirants and Study Group members are not required to submit dues.

Apostolate Reports

The requirement to submit 2021 Apostolate Reports in February 2022 has been waived due to the pandemic.

Membership Rosters

Remember to submit an updated membership roster to the OCDS Central Office (see address above) whenever ceremonies are completed or other changes in membership occur. You can obtain the Excel form on ocds.info/forms. Be sure to include the name and location of your Community or Group when submitting your roster to the OCDS Central Office.

Meeting in Person

Remember that OCDS monthly meetings should be held in person, if at all possible, when there is no dispensation from attending Sunday Mass in your diocese.


Bl. Marie-Eugene has been added to the Carmelite Proper as an <u>Optional</u> <u>Memorial on February 4</u>. This year we are celebrating the 100 year anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood.

The Optional Memorial may be celebrated with the Common of Pastors and the Proper Prayer: O Lord, You are rich in mercy, and you gave Blessed Marie-Eugene of the Child Jesus grace and light to lead your people on the paths of contemplative prayer and missionary witness, towards the fullness of Christ. Grant us, by his prayers, to grow in docility to the Holy Spirit and to work, in faith, for the coming of Your Kingdom. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, Who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.

Bl. Marie-Eugene was born in 1894 in Southern France. His father, a miner, died when Bl. Marie Eugene was ten years old. He was able to receive an education, and he entered the seminary in 1911. However, his preparation for the priesthood was interrupted when he entered the army in 1913. He served during WWI in several campaigns before returning to the seminary.

In 1920, while on retreat in preparation for his ordination to the diaconate, Bl. Marie-Eugene experienced a strong call to the Discalced Carmelite Order while reading a book about the life of St. John of the Cross. His desire was met with opposition, and he was ordained as a diocesan priest on February 4, 1922. But, his call to Carmel could not be denied. A few weeks later on February 24, 1922, he entered the Discalced Carmelite Order. Over the years, he held several positions within the Order, but his great love was teaching our beautiful spirituality. He died on Easter Monday, March 27, 1967, the feast day he had established to celebrate the Institute Notre-Dame de Vie, which he founded.
